The mission of the Léa Roback Research Centre is to help reduce social inequalities in health and improve living conditions.

The Centre has four main functions in the Montréal community:

- 1- to facilitate research on social inequalities in health shaped by living conditions,
- 2- to develop alliances among researchers from diverse fields, public policymakers and professionals in institutional and community settings to support the conduct and application of such research,
- 3- to enhance knowledge transfer so that research results can be transformed into action, and
- 4- to assemble a critical mass of researchers working in the area of social inequalities in health.

The Centre is pursuing these goals in collaboration with similar centres internationally.
